- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-41 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the implementation of operational guidelines and training for law
- 3 enforcement officers and state's attorneys addressing the crimes of human trafficking,
- 4 prostitution, and the commercial exploitation of children.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-41 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 <u>Law enforcement guidelines Training Prevention.</u>
- 9 <u>1. Each law enforcement agency shall develop and implement specific operational</u>
- guidelines for handling a crime involving human trafficking, prostitution, or commercial
- 11 <u>exploitation of children.</u>
- 12 <u>a. The guidelines must include procedures for:</u>
- 13 (1) Conducting a criminal investigation;
- 14 (2) Arresting a suspect;
- 15 (3) Assisting a victim;
- 16 (4) Connecting a victim with services; and
- 17 (5) Any additional procedures necessary to carry out this chapter.
- 18 <u>b.</u> The attorney general shall assist a law enforcement agency in the development
  19 and implementation of procedures.
- 20 <u>2.</u> The peace officer standards and training board shall establish a training and education
- 21 <u>program for law enforcement officers and state's attorneys on detecting, responding</u>
- 22 <u>to, and investigating a crime involving human trafficking, prostitution, or commercial</u>
- exploitation of children.
- 24 <u>a. The training must include information on community resources for a victim.</u>

1	<u>b.</u>	<u>The</u>	training must be:
2		<u>(1)</u>	Trauma-informed and victim-centered in approach;
3		<u>(2)</u>	Developed in conjunction with state's attorneys;
4		<u>(3)</u>	Implemented as a ten-hour requirement for the law enforcement academy
5			initial officer training; and
6		<u>(4)</u>	Included as a five-hour continuing education requirement during the life of a
7			peace officer license.
