#### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

# 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - LIMITING THE RELEASE OF SELF-SPREADING VIRUSES AND BACTERIA.

- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying limiting the development and release of self-spreading viruses and bacteria. The study must include:
- a. A review of the persons and entities developing or releasing self-spreading
  viruses or bacteria;
  - b. The impact of the development and release of self-spreading viruses and bacteria, including all available data on adverse reactions and long-term effects;
  - c. Appropriate limitations and enforcement measures, including potential sanctions and penalties; and
  - d. Possible exceptions to the limitations.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
