3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND

5 IMPROVEMENTS FUND - DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS - VETERANS'

6 NATIONAL CEMETERY GRANT - ONE-TIME FUNDING. Subject to the provisions of this 7 section, there is appropriated out of any moneys in the strategic investment and improvements 8 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of the 9 sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs, for the purpose of providing a 10 grant to a nonprofit organization for construction costs associated with the construction of a 11 chapel, parking lot, and related infrastructure at a veterans' national cemetery in the state, for 12 the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The funding provided in this 13 section is considered a one-time funding item. The funding provided in this section is available 14 only upon certification by the department of veterans' affairs to the director of the office of 15 management and budget that the United States department of veterans affairs national 16 cemetery administration will provide planning and oversight for the project.
