- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-12 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to postpartum doula certification
- 3 and medical assistance benefits for postpartum doula services.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows:

- 7 Postpartum doula certification.
- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>
- 9 <u>a.</u> "Certified doula" means an individual who has received a certification to perform
 10 <u>doula services from the doulas of North America or an organization designated</u>
 11 <u>by the department.</u>
- 12 b. "Department" means the department of health and human services.
- c. "Doula services" means education and support services for a parent and child,
 including continuous emotional and physical support during the postpartum
 period, including up to six months after the birth of the child.
- 16 <u>2.</u> <u>The department may:</u>
- 17 <u>a.</u> <u>Designate additional doula certification organizations;</u>
- 18 b. Remove the designation of a doula certification organization; and
- 19 <u>c.</u> <u>Adopt rules to implement and administer this section.</u>
- 20 <u>3.</u> <u>The department shall establish criteria for the designation of doula certification</u>
- 21 organizations and maintain a list of designated organizations on the department's
- 22 website for purposes of facilitating the availability of certified doulas to provide doula
- 23 services under section 2 of this Act.

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- 1 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 2 and enacted as follows:

3 Medical assistance benefits - Postpartum doula services.

- 4 <u>1.</u> <u>Medical assistance coverage, including Medicaid expansion coverage, must include</u>
- 5 <u>coverage of postpartum doula services, as defined in section 1 of this Act.</u>
- 6 <u>2.</u> The department shall provide notice to an enrollee regarding the coverage required by
 7 <u>this section.</u>
