6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:

8 Postpartum doula certification.

<u>1. As used in this section:</u>

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- a. "Certified doula" means an individual who has received a certification to perform
 doula services from the doulas of North America or an organization designated
 by the department.
- b. "Department" means the department of health and human services.
- 14 <u>c.</u> "Doula services" means education and support services for a parent and child,
 15 <u>including continuous emotional and physical support during the postpartum</u>
 16 <u>period, including up to six months after the birth of the child.</u>
- 17 <u>2. The department may:</u>
- 18 <u>a. Designate additional doula certification organizations;</u>
- b. Remove the designation of a doula certification organization; and
- 20 c. Adopt rules to implement and administer this section.

1 The department shall establish criteria for the designation of doula certification 2 organizations and maintain a list of designated organizations on the department's 3 website for purposes of facilitating the availability of certified doulas to provide doula 4 services under section 2 of this Act. 5 The department may not impose a licensing or certification fee in addition to any fees 6 imposed by a doula certification organization meeting the criteria established by the 7 department. 8 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 9 and enacted as follows: 10 Medical assistance benefits - Postpartum doula services. 11 1. Medical assistance coverage, including Medicaid expansion coverage, must include 12 coverage of postpartum doula services, as defined in section 1 of this Act. 13 2. The department shall provide notice to an enrollee regarding the coverage required by 14 this section. 15 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT REPORT - POSTPARTUM DOULA 16 **CERTIFICATION.** During the 2025-26 interim, the department of health and human services 17 shall provide a report to the legislative management regarding postpartum doula certification, 18 including the status of implementing and administering the responsibilities relating to 19 postpartum doula certification under section 1 of this Act and the impact of certified doula 20
