- 13 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 26.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

- <u>A health care sharing ministry may not be considered to be engaging in the business</u>
   <u>of insurance and is exempt from regulations applicable to insurance entities.</u>

- 20a.Is recognized as tax exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal21Revenue Code [26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3)];
