- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of the dementia response program; and to provide an
- 3 appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Dementia response program.</u>
- 8 The department shall establish a dementia response program to be administered by a state
- 9 dementia coordinator. The dementia response program shall:
- 10 <u>1. Implement an Alzheimer's and dementia state plan;</u>
- 11 2. Update the Alzheimer's and dementia state plan every three years by convening a
 work group that includes:
- 13 <u>a. Individuals living with dementia;</u>
- b. Care partners and family members of individuals living with dementia;
- 15 <u>c. Representatives of home and facility-based care professionals;</u>
- 16 <u>d.</u> Representatives of the medical profession with experience in diagnosing and
 17 treating Alzheimer's and dementia;
- 18 <u>e. A representative of a leading national organization that advocates on behalf of</u>
 19 <u>individuals living with Alzheimer's or dementia; and</u>
- 20 <u>f. A representative of an organization that advocates for older adults;</u>
- 21 <u>3.</u> Collect and disseminate Alzheimer's and dementia data through the use of data
- 22 <u>collected by the state and use of the behavioral risk factor surveillance system,</u>
- 23 <u>including caregiver and cognitive decline models, on a rotating basis; and</u>

1	<u>4.</u>	Implement a statewide public awareness campaign that includes information to reduce
2		stigma, encourage risk reduction activity, and emphasize the importance of early
3		detection and diagnosis.
4	SEC	CTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES -
5	DEMEN	TIA RESPONSE PROGRAM - FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION. There is
6	appropri	iated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
7	appropri	iated, the sum of \$250,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the
8	departm	ent of health and human services for the purpose of administering the dementia
9	respons	e program, the behavioral risk factor surveillance models, and for a full-time equivalent
10	position	to administer the program as the state dementia coordinator, for the biennium
11	beginnir	ng July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.
