- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to a determination by the department of health and human

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 50-25.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows: 7 The department or authorized agent shall determine the military status of anany 8 individual subject to an assessment, within a reasonable amount of time, if the 9 individual's child is the subjectat the initiation of ana child abuse or neglect 10 allegation assessment. If the department determines an allegation of abuse or neglect 11 involves a military-affiliated individual, the department shall notify the nearest military 12 installation's family advocacy program of the allegation and investigation. The military 13 installation is responsible for reporting the data to the federal department of defense. 14 The department may develop a memorandum of understanding for use by the human 15 service zone. For purposes of this subsection: 16 "Military-affiliated individual" means an individual with an active military status 17 and the individual's dependents. 18 "Military status" includes any branch of the United States military, and the 19 national quard or reserve.
