- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 28-32 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the expiration of administrative rules and a review process
- 3 administered by the governor; and to amend and reenact section 28-32-06 of the North Dakota
- 4 Century Code, relating to the force and effect of administrative rules.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 28-32-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **28-32-06.** Force and effect of rules.
- 9 Upon becoming effective, rules have a rule has the force and effect of law until amended:
- 10 <u>1. Amended or repealed by the agency or commission, declared in accordance with this chapter;</u>
- 12 <u>2. Declared invalid by a final court decision, suspended;</u>
 - 3. Suspended or found to be void by the administrative rules committee, or determined;
- 14 <u>4.</u> One year after the rule is determined expired by the governor under section 2 of this
- 15 Act; or

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- 5. <u>Determined</u> repealed by the legislative council because the authority for adoption of
 the rules is repealed or transferred to another agency.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 28-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 19 and enacted as follows:
- 20 <u>Expiration of administrative rules Governor Rule review process Rules.</u>
- A rule expires on January first ten years after its effective date as published by the
 legislative council in the North Dakota Administrative Code.
- 23 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, if a rule is effective before January 1, 2026, the expiration date must be determined by the governor.

1	<u>3.</u>	<u>The</u>	governor shall:
2		<u>a.</u>	Provide notice of an expiration date of a rule to the commission or agency before
3			one year before the expiration date.
4		<u>b.</u>	Organize and publish a table containing each rule and the expiration date for the
5			rule.
6		<u>C.</u>	Review a rule before it expires. Upon review, the governor may update the
7			expiration date for another ten years or determine the rule is expired. If the
8			governor determines the rule is expired, the governor shall require the agency or
9			commission to amend or repeal the rule in accordance with this chapter within
10			one year of the expiration date of the rule.
11		<u>d.</u>	Adopt rules in accordance with this chapter to implement the rule expiration and
12			review process under this section.
13	<u>4.</u>	An a	agency or the commission shall provide to the governor a report to facilitate the
14		revi	ew process under this section, in accordance with rules adopted by the governor.
15	<u>5.</u>	<u>The</u>	governor may:
16		<u>a.</u>	Exempt a rule from the requirements under this section.
17		<u>b.</u>	Grant an extension to an agency or commission.
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
