- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the assessment of all public school buildings; and to provide an
- 3 appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:
- 7 School buildings Assessment Rules.
- 8 <u>The superintendent of public instruction:</u>
- 9 <u>1.</u> <u>Shall collect regularly conducted assessments by school districts of each building</u>
- 10 located on school grounds in the state, including the interior and exterior of the
- 11 <u>building, doors, windows, fire sprinklers, fire protection systems, components of</u>
- heating, cooling, plumbing, electrical, and security systems, and handicap accessibility
 features.
- Shall, every four years, document the inventory of buildings, including building type,
 original construction year, facility additions, facility addition construction year, and
- 16 <u>facility square footage as submitted by school districts.</u>
- 17 <u>3.</u> <u>Develop and maintain a system for tracking the assessments of buildings, including</u>
 18 construction, repairs, modifications, and maintenance recommended for each school.
- 19 <u>4.</u> <u>Shall adopt rules under chapter 28-32 to implement this section.</u>

1	5. May contract for professional services to implement this section, including contracting
2	to study appropriate criteria to establish for public school facility standards.

4	BUILDING ASSESSMENTS - ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated out of any moneys-
5	in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$4,000,000, or
6	so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of public instruction for the
7	purpose of providing for a statewide facilities assessment for the biennium beginning July 1,
8	2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The funding provided in this section is considered a one-time
9	funding item.
