- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the legislative assembly for hiring temporary
- 2 legislative assistants; to provide for an analysis of capitol office space; and to provide for a
- 3 report to the legislative management.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY - TEMPORARY

- 6 **LEGISLATIVE ASSISTANTS.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
- 7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,300,000, or so much of the sum as
- 8 may be necessary, to the legislative assembly for the purpose defraying the expenses of each
- 9 legislator hiring a temporary legislative assistant during legislative sessions, for the biennium
- 10 beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.

11 SECTION 2. OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET OFFICE SPACE ANALYSIS -

- 12 **REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.** The director of the office of management and
- 13 budget shall perform an analysis of office space in the capitol. The director shall determine
- 14 which state agencies in the capitol and the judicial wing of the capitol occupy excess space due
- 15 to the movement over the last five years toward hybrid and remote work arrangements. The
- 16 director shall prepare recommendations for the consolidation of executive branch agency office
- 17 space and provide hoteling options to reduce the office space needs of agencies and for the
- 18 reduction of the amount of space used for meeting rooms and conference rooms that could be
- 19 consolidated. The director also shall provide recommendations for the location of workspace for
- 20 temporary legislative assistants authorized under section 1 of this Act. The director shall provide
- 21 the recommendations to the legislative management by August 15, 2026.
