- 1 A BILL for an Act to create a committee to study special education funding during the 2025-26
- 2 interim; and to provide for a legislative management report.

### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

### 4 SECTION 1. SPECIAL EDUCATION FUNDING COMMITTEE - REPORT TO

#### LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT.

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- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall establish and provide staffing and administrative services to a committee to study special education funding. The chairman of legislative management may add temporary, nonvoting members to the committee, as deemed necessary by the committee, to serve without compensation.
- 2. The committee may include:
  - Eight members of the legislative assembly, four members from the house of representatives and four members from the senate, appointed by the legislative management;
- b. Two multi-unit special education directors;
- 16 c. One large school special education director;
- d. One special education coordinator;
- e. One superintendent of a large school;
- f. One superintendent of a small or midsize school;
- g. One business manager of a large school; and
- h. One multi-unit special education business manager.

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- During the 2025-26 interim, the special education funding committee study must
  include a comprehensive review of special education funding models, including
  student contracts, high-cost students, residential placement, and reimbursement under
  the Medicaid program.
  - 4. The committee shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
