PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO FIRST ENGROSSMENT

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 16.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the secretary of state's duty to distribute educational and informational
- 3 materials before an election; to provide an appropriation; and to provide an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 16.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Secretary of state to distribute information to qualified electors regarding ballot</u>

8 <u>measures.</u>

- 9 <u>1.</u> For each statewide constitutional measure approved by the legislative assembly,
- 10 <u>initiated measure, or referendum appearing on the ballot of a special, primary, or</u>
- 11 general election, the secretary of state shall create and distribute objective and factual
- 12 educational materials to each individual listed as "secured active" in the central voter
- file not less than forty-five days before the election at which the question will be voted
 upon.
- 15 <u>2.</u> <u>The materials created and distributed under subsection 1 must contain:</u>
- 16 <u>a.</u> <u>An objective summary of the measure;</u>
- 17 <u>b.</u> <u>The anticipated fiscal impact of the measure;</u>
- 18 <u>c.</u> Whether the measure was approved by the legislative assembly or originated as
 19 <u>an initiative or referred petition; and</u>

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| 1 | d. An objective analysis of a vote in favor and a vote opposed. |
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| 2 | SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - SECRETARY OF STATE - BALLOT MEASURE |
| 3 | EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS - ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated out of any moneys |
| 4 | in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$600,000, or so |
| 5 | much of the sum as may be necessary, to the secretary of state for the purpose of creating and |
| 6 | distributing objective and factual educational materials focusing on the accuracy, fairness, and |
| 7 | readability of measures placed on a statewide election ballot as provided in section 1 of this Act, |
| 8 | for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The funding in this section |
| 9 | is considered a one-time funding item. |
| 10 | SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 2027, and after that |
| 11 | date is ineffective. |
