- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-24.5 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to adult residential facility payment rates; to amend and reenact section
- 3 50-24.5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of adult residential
- 4 facility; and to provide an appropriation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-24.5-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **50-24.5-01. Definitions.**
- 9 In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 1. "Adult residential facility" means a licensed basic care facility, specializing in the care
- 11 of individuals eligible for services under a medical assistance home and community-
- based waiver or similar program with chronic moderate to severe memory loss or
- significant emotional, behavioral, or cognitive impairment, which provides therapeutic,
- social, and recreational programming and assistance with activities of daily living and
- 15 <u>instrumental activities of daily living.</u>
- 16 <u>2.</u> "Aged" means at least sixty-five years of age.
- 17 2.3. "Blind" has the same meaning as the term has when used by the social security
- administration in the supplemental security income program under titles II and XVI of
- the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 401-434 and 42 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.].
- 20 3.4. "Congregate housing" means housing shared by two or more individuals not related to
- each other which is not provided in an institution.
- 22 4.5. "Department" means the department of health and human services.

1 "Disabled" has the same meaning as the term has when used by the social security 5.6. 2 administration in the supplemental security income program under titles II and XVI of 3 the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 401-434 and 42 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.]. 4 "Eligible beneficiary" means a resident of this state who: 6.7. 5 (1) Is aged; or a. 6 (2) Is at least eighteen years of age and is disabled or blind; 7 (1) Has applied for and is eligible to receive and receives benefits under title b. 8 XIX of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.], and who has applied 9 for and is receiving benefits, if the individual is eligible to receive benefits, 10 under titles II and XVI of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 401-434 and 11 42 U.S.C. 1381 et seg.]; or 12 (2) Has applied for and is eligible to receive and receives benefits under section 13 50-24.1-37 for long-term services and supports pursuant to an asset test 14 established under title XIX of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396] 15 et seq.] and section 50-24.1-02; 16 Meets the requirements of section 23-09.3-08.1; C. 17 d. Based on a functional assessment, is not severely impaired in any of the 18 activities of daily living of toileting, transferring to or from a bed or chair, or eating 19 and: 20 (1) Has health, welfare, or safety needs, including a need for supervision or a 21 structured environment; or 22 Is impaired in three of the following four instrumental activities of daily living: (2) 23 preparing meals, doing housework, taking medicine, and doing laundry; and 24 Is determined to be eligible pursuant to rules adopted by the department. 25 7.8. "Human service zone" means a county or consolidated group of counties 26 administering human services within a designated area in accordance with an 27 agreement or plan approved by the department. 28 "Institution" means a facility licensed under chapter 23-09.3. 8.9. 29 9.10. "Living independently" includes living in congregate housing. The term does not 30 include living in an institution.

1 10.11. "Personal needs allowance" means an amount retained by the eligible beneficiary to 2 cover the costs of clothing and other personal needs. 3 11.12. "Proprietor" means an individual responsible for day-to-day administration and 4 management of a facility. 5 "Remedial care" means services that produce the maximum reduction of an eligible 12.13. 6 beneficiary's physical or mental disability and the restoration of an eligible beneficiary 7 to the beneficiary's best possible functional level. 8 "Would be eligible to receive the cash benefits except for income" refers to an 13.14. 9 individual whose countable income, less the cost of necessary remedial care that may 10 be provided under this chapter, does not exceed an amount equal to the cash benefit 11 under titles II and XVI of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 401-434 and 12 42 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.] which the individual would receive if the individual had no 13 income, plus the amount allowed as the personal needs allowance. 14 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 50-24.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 15 and enacted as follows: 16 Adult residential facility payment rates - Report. 17 <u>1.</u> The department shall determine rates for the care of residents of adult residential 18 facilities which are sufficient to assure there are enough providers available to meet 19 demand. 20 <u>2.</u> The department shall increase rates for inflation for the year beginning: 21 July 1, 2025, by four percent; and <u>a.</u> 22 July 1, 2026, by three percent. b. 23 The department shall require an adult residential facility to submit simplified cost <u>3.</u> 24 reports by October 31, 2025, which the department shall use to pay the facility its 25 current costs beginning January 1, 2026. 26 Beginning January 1, 2026, a five percent operating margin must be included in adult <u>4.</u> 27 residential facility rates. 28 The department shall require adult residential facilities to submit simplified cost reports 5. 29 by December 31, 2026, which the department shall use to provide a rate recalculation

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES ADULT RESIDENTIAL FACILITY RATE ADMINISTRATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special

- 4 funds derived from federal funds and other income, the sum of \$2,200,000, or so much of the
- 5 sum as may be necessary, to the department of health and human services for the purpose of
- 6 administering adult residential facility rates, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
- 7 June 30, 2027.
