- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 11 of section 4.1-41-01 and section
- 2 4.1-41-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to pet food registration.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 11 of section 4.1-41-01 of the North Dakota

- 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 11. "Labeling" means the written, <u>printed</u>, <u>or graphic</u> information accompanying the
- 7 distribution of commercial feed or customer-formula feed, including promotional
- 8 materials distributed to market the feed <u>and statements and promotions through radio</u>,
- 9 <u>television, or internet interface, or on an organization's website</u>.
- 10 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-41-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 11 amended and reenacted as follows:

12 **4.1-41-05.** Pet food - Specialty pet food - Registration - Exemption - Penalty.

- Before being distributed in this state, each pet food product and each specialty pet
 food product must be registered with the commissioner. This requirement does not
 apply to a distributor, provided the pet food or specialty pet food is registered by
 another person.
- 17 2. To register <u>and renew</u> pet food and specialty pet food, a person shall submit:
- 18 a. An application form at the time and in the manner required by the commissioner;
 19 and
- 20 b. A fee in the amount of one hundred twenty dollars per product <u>manufactured</u>
 21 <u>out-of-state; and</u>
- 22 <u>c.</u> <u>A fee in the amount of fifty dollars per product manufactured in the state</u>.
- 23 3. To renew a registration required by this section, a person shall submit:

3		b.	A fee in the amount of one hundred dollars per product.
4	4.	A re	gistration issued under this section is valid during the period beginning on January
5		first	of an even-numbered year and ending on December thirty-first of the ensuing
6		odd	-numbered year.
7	<u>5.4.</u>	lf a	person fails to renew a registration within thirty-one days of its expiration, that
8		pers	son must apply for an initial registration.
9	6. 5.	Upo	n approving an application for an initial registration or a renewed registration, the
10		com	missioner shall furnish a certificate of registration to the applicant. A certificate of
11		regi	stration is not transferable.
12	7.<u>6.</u>	Any	person violating this section is subject to a penalty of twenty-five dollars for each
13		proc	duct that must be registered.
14	8.<u>7.</u>	Ape	erson is exempt from this section if the person:
15		a.	Is a resident of this state;
16		<u>b.</u>	Produces pet food in a noncommercial kitchen;
17		b.<u>c.</u>	Sells the pet food directly to the end consumer at a community event or farmer's
18			market; and
19		c.<u>d.</u>	Does not use meat, poultry, fish, or their byproducts as an ingredient in the
20			product.
