**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
FIRST ENGROSSMENT**

**ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1554**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-17.8-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory board; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-17.8-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **54-17.8-06. North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory board - Members.**

7 1. There is created a North Dakota outdoor heritage advisory board consisting of twelve  
8 members. The governor shall appoint representatives from each of the groups listed in  
9 this section based upon recommendations made by the appropriate group. The  
10 advisory board consists of:

11 a. Four members from the agriculture community. The governor shall appoint one  
12 member from the North Dakota farm bureau, North Dakota farmers union, the  
13 North Dakota stockmen's association, and the North Dakota grain growers  
14 association.

15 b. Two members from the energy industry. The governor shall appoint one member  
16 from the North Dakota petroleum council and one member from the lignite energy  
17 council.

18 c. Four members from the conservation community. The governor shall appoint the  
19 members from the conservation community at large of statewide conservation  
20 groups.

- 1           d. One member from the business community from the greater North Dakota  
2           chamber.
- 3           e. One member from the North Dakota recreation and park association.
- 4           2. The governor also shall appoint to the advisory board one representative from each of  
5           the following agencies to serve as ex officio, nonvoting technical members: the  
6           department of parks and recreation, the department of water resources, the game and  
7           fish department, the office of the state forester, and the North Dakota association of  
8           soil conservation districts.
- 9           3. The term of office of each member of the board is four years and members may not  
10          serve more than two consecutive terms. The terms of office commence on the first day  
11          of July. The initial terms for the advisory board members must be staggered following  
12          a method determined by the board.
- 13          4. The advisory board shall select a chairman from among the members. Seven voting  
14          members is a quorum at any meeting.
- 15          5. The advisory board shall have at least two regular meetings each year and additional  
16          meetings as the chairman determines necessary at a time and place to be fixed by the  
17          chairman. Special meetings must be called by the chairman on written request of any  
18          five members.
- 19          6. The advisory board may not forward a grant application to the commission unless the  
20          application is for funding activities that fulfill the purposes of this chapter and the  
21          application receives a favorable recommendation from a majority of the advisory board  
22          members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present.
- 23          7. Members of the advisory board appointed by the governor serve at the pleasure of the  
24          governor.

25          **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
