- 2 Century Code, relating to a tribal-state gaming compact that permits gaming in Grand Forks

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 54-58-03 of the North Dakota Century
6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 5. The compact may not authorize gaming to be conducted by an Indian tribe at any 8 off-reservation location not permitted under a tribal-state gaming compact in effect on 9 August 1, 1997, except that in the case of the tribal-state gaming compact between 10 the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa and the state, gaming may be conducted on 11 land within Rolette County held in trust for the Band by the United States government 12 which was in trust as of the effective date of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act of 1988 13 [Pub. L. 100-497; 102 Stat. 2467; 25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.] and on land within Grand 14 Forks County, if approved by the secretary of the interior under the Indian Gaming

15 Regulatory Act of 1988 [Pub. L. 100-497; 102 Stat. 2467; 25 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.].
