4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE EMPLOYEE 5 COMPENSATION. 6 During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the 7 classified state employee total rewards compensation system, including a review of 8 the development and determination of pay grades and grade, classifications, and 9 health care benefits. The study, if conducted, must include a review of the: 10 The history of changes to classification and pay grade levels, comparisons; a. 11 Comparisons among state employees across all departments and between state b. 12 employee compensation levels to similar private sector jobs, the; 13 The use of equity funding and bonuses to retain employees, the; C. 14 d. The payment of prevailing wages on state projects, and consideration of wage; 15 Wage levels in awarding contracts for state projects; e. 16 f. The impact of changes to health plan benefits; and 17 Premium rate structures for single and family coverage and the impact of any g. 18 proposed changes.
