- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of commerce for tribal tourism
- 2 grants; and to provide for a legislative management report.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - TRIBAL TOURISM

5 **GRANTS - ONE-TIME FUNDING - LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT REPORT.** There is

6 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise

7 appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the

8 department of commerce for the purpose of providing tribal tourism grants, for the biennium

9 beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. A tribal government in the state may apply to

10 the department of commerce for a grant of up to \$20,000 to match funds committed by a tribal

- 11 government to promote and enhance tribal nation tourism opportunities. A grant application
- 12 must include a plan for using funds to promote and enhance tribal nation tourism opportunities
- 13 to be overseen by the department of commerce division of tourism. The department of
- 14 commerce shall report to legislative management regarding the distribution, use, and impact of
- 15 grants. The funding provided in this section is considered a one-time funding item.
