**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with Senate Amendments**

**ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1600**

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-11 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to the establishment of the immigration law clinic at the university of  
3 North Dakota school of law; to provide for a report; and to provide an appropriation.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created  
6 and enacted as follows:

7 **Immigration law clinic.**

- 8 1. The university of North Dakota school of law shall employ one full-time staff attorney  
9 for the immigration law clinic. The immigration law clinic attorney may not have more  
10 than sixty matters open at any one time.  
11 2. Legal services may be provided and legal work may be done remotely, depending on  
12 the needs of the client.  
13 3. The university of North Dakota law school may charge nominal fees, as needed, to  
14 operate the immigration law clinic.

15 **SECTION 2. UNIVERSITY OF NORTH DAKOTA SCHOOL OF LAW - IMMIGRATION LAW**  
16 **CLINIC - REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The university of North Dakota school of  
17 law shall prepare a report on the status of the immigration law clinic, including the impact of the  
18 operation of the immigration law clinic on the school of law, the sustainability of the clinic based  
19 on fee collection, the number of law students interested in participating in the clinic, the number  
20 of law students participating in the clinic, and the student's hours of involvement. The report  
21 also must include the number of businesses, employers, and individuals seeking legal services,  
22 the location of the individuals or entities seeking services, and the scope of work requested. The

1 report also must identify any obstacles encountered in developing the clinic, potential future  
2 challenges for the clinic, a detailed plan to meet these challenges, and any legislation  
3 necessary to support the recommendations for the clinic's successful operation. The university  
4 of North Dakota school of law shall present the report to the seventieth and seventy-first  
5 legislative assemblies.

6 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET -**  
7 **IMMIGRATION LAW CLINIC.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in  
8 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$400,000, or so much of the sum as  
9 may be necessary, to the office of management and budget for the purpose of providing a grant  
10 to the university of North Dakota to fund an immigration law clinic at the university of North  
11 Dakota school of law, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.
