- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 11-28.3-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to rural ambulance board compensation.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 11-28.3-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

## 6 **11-28.3-06. Organization - Board of directors.**

- 71.At the time and place fixed by the county auditor for the public meeting as provided in8section 11-28.3-05, the qualified electors present who reside within the boundaries of9the district shall proceed to organize the district. Permanent organization must be10effected by the election of a board of directors consisting of not less than five nor more11than ten residents of the district. The board of directors shall meet as soon after the12organizational meeting as possible to elect a president, a vice president, and a13secretary-treasurer.
- 14 <u>2.</u> All directors and officers must be elected for two years and hold office until their 15 successors have been elected and qualified, except that at the first election the vice 16 president must be elected as provided in this section for a one-year term, and 17 one-half, or as close to one-half as possible depending upon the total number of 18 directors, of the directors elected at the first election after July 1, 1977, must be 19 selected by lot in the presence of a majority of such directors to serve one-year terms. 20 3. A district may specify in its bylaws a specified number of directors within the limitations 21 in this section, provided each township or group of townships receives equal
- representation on the board with respect to the regions. The bylaws also may allow fora combination of regional directors and at-large directors.

1	<u>4.</u>	If a vacancy occurs in a board position due to a resignation, a special meeting must be
2		called and held within sixty days of the resignation for the purpose of electing a
3		director to serve the remainder of the term. All officers and directors shall serve
4		without pay, except the secretary-treasurer, who may be paid a salary-
5		determinedBoard members may receive compensation at a rate set by the board of
6		directors. No more than two elected members of the board may be members of the
7		licensed ambulance service serving the district territory and those board members
8		must meet the definition of volunteer in section 23-27-04.1.
