1 A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 9 of article III and section 16 of article IV 2 of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to requiring each resolution adopted by the 3 legislative assembly proposing a constitutional amendment and each initiative petition and 4 measure proposing a constitutional amendment to be comprised of a single subject. 5 STATEMENT OF INTENT 6 This measure would require each resolution adopted by the legislative assembly proposing a 7 constitutional amendment and each initiative petition and measure proposing a constitutional 8 amendment to be comprised of a single subject. 9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF 10 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 11 That the following proposed amendments to section 9 of article III and section 16 of 12 article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and must be submitted to the 13 qualified electors of North Dakota at the general election to be held in November of 2026, in 14 accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota. 15 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 9 of article III of the Constitution of North Dakota is 16 amended and reenacted as follows: 17 **Section 9.** A constitutional amendment may be proposed by initiative petition. The 18 proposed amendment may not embrace or be comprised of more than one subject, as 19 determined by the secretary of state, and the secretary of state may not approve the initiative 20 petition for circulation if the proposed amendment comprises more than one subject. If signed 21 by electors equal in number to four percent of the resident population of the state at the last

federal decennial census, the petition may be submitted to the secretary of state. All other

- 3 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota is
- 4 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 5 **Section 16.** Any amendment to this constitution may be proposed in either house of the
- 6 legislative assembly, and if. The proposed amendment may not embrace or be comprised of
- 7 more than one subject. If agreed to upon a roll call by a majority of the members elected to
- 8 each house, must be submitted to the electors and if a majority of the votes cast thereonupon
- 9 the question are in the affirmative, the amendment is a part of this constitution.
