- 2 regulatory framework and potential economic impact of tetrahydrocannabinol infused
- 3 beverages.
- 4 **WHEREAS**, the North Dakota Department of Agriculture regulates hemp and other varieties
- 5 of cannabis sativa for agriculture and industrial purposes; and
- 6 **WHEREAS**, the tetrahydrocannabinol in cannabis beverages often is derived from hemp
- 7 because it is legal to produce under federal law; and
- 8 WHEREAS, tetrahydrocannabinol and cannabinoid hemp beverages are emerging in the
- 9 national marketplace as an alternative to alcoholic beverage with fewer after effects;
- 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
- 11 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 12 That the Legislative Management consider studying regulatory framework and potential
- 13 economic impact of tetrahydrocannabinol infused beverages in the state; and
- 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 16 the Seventieth Legislative Assembly.
