AMENDMENT.** Section 25 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is 13 amended and reenacted as follows: 14 **Section 25.** The legislative assembly shallmay not authorize any game of chance, lottery, 15 or gift enterprises, under any pretense, or for any purpose whatever. However, the legislative
