4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-30-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 43-30-16. Examination, license, and registration fees.
- The board may establish by rule and charge the following fees:
 - The fee to be paid by an applicant for an examination to determine the applicant's fitness to receive a license as a private investigator or a license to provide private security services may not exceed one hundred two hundred dollars.
 - 2. The fee to be paid by an applicant for the initial issuance or the renewal of a license as a private investigator or a license to provide private security services may not exceed one hundred fiftythree hundred dollars. A late fee not to exceed fiftyone hundred dollars may be charged for each month the renewal fee is due and unpaid.
 - 3. The fee to be paid by an applicant to apply for a license to conduct a private security or detective agency may not exceed one hundred two hundred dollars.
- 4. The fee for the issuance or the renewal of a license to conduct a private security or
 detective agency may not exceed three hundredsix hundred dollars. A late fee not to
 exceed one hundredtwo hundred dollars may be charged for each month the renewal
 fee is due and unpaid.

- The one-timeinitial fee to be paid by an applicant for the issuance of a private security training certificate may not exceed twenty-fivesixty dollars. The fee for the renewal of a private security training certificate may not exceed sixty dollars. A late fee not to exceed twenty dollars may be charged for each month the renewal fee is due and unpaid.
 - 6. The annual fee to be paid by an applicant for the issuance of an armed certificate may not exceed thirtysixty dollars. A late fee not to exceed tentwenty dollars may be charged for each month the renewal fee is due and unpaid.
 - 7. The fee to be paid for the issuance of a duplicate license may not exceed twenty forty dollars.
 - 8. The initial registration fee to provide private investigative service or private security service may not exceed thirtysixty dollars. The fee for the renewal of a registration to provide private investigative service or private security service may not exceed thirtysixty dollars. A late fee not to exceed tentwenty dollars may be charged for each month the renewal fee is due and unpaid.
 - The initial application fee for a certified course instructor for an armed first responder training certification may not exceed <u>four hundredeight hundred</u> dollars. A fee for renewal of a course instructor certification for an armed first responder program may not exceed <u>three hundredsix</u> hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
