Page 1, lines 9-12, as well as page 2 lines 18-22, allow the ACT score to be replaced by a score on the new NDA+ exam that is equivalent to a score of 24 on the ACT. Page 4 lines 2-7 allows military courses that are currently being developed to be used to meet the additional indicators in the Military Ready pathway of the North Dakota Scholarship.

Information provided by the Department of Public Instruction indicates no anticipated fiscal impact in HB 1404, as the bill provides additional options for students that are currently able to use other indicators to qualify for the ND Scholarship. We anticipate that students who take the NDA+ in 10th grade and achieve the score that is considered to be equivalent to a 24 on the ACT will chose not to take the ACT in grades 11 or 12, meaning it will be the same number of total students, but just with more than one option for achieving the required test level. We also anticipate that students who take the military courses will be doing so in place of the other additional indicators options that they already have, which will not increase the total number of students that qualify, but give that same number of students additional options to achieve the indicators.
