For the 2025-27 biennium, there would be one-time savings because the Legislative Assembly would meet for fewer days during January through June of 2027. Ongoing expenses beginning in the 2027-29 biennium would increase because, although the Legislative Assembly would meet for the same number of legislative days, legislator pay and mileage and lodging costs would increase because of additional travel days throughout the biennium. The cost of temporary session employees is also anticipated to increase. The amounts shown do not reflect any change to cost of the interim legislative committee process, anticipating it would continue similarly to the current process.
