How to Apply

Login using an existing [North Dakota Login](#), or register for a new [North Dakota Login](#). Once logged in, start a new application in the “Funding for Infrastructure in ND – FIND “ funding opportunity.”

Use of Proceeds

Funds may be used for capital construction projects to construct new infrastructure or replace existing infrastructure, which provide the fixed installations necessary for the function of a political subdivision including:

- The Red River Valley Water Supply Project
- Water treatment plants
- Wastewater treatment plants
- Sewerlines and waterlines, including lift stations and pumping systems
- Storm water infrastructure, including curb and gutter construction
- Water storage systems, including dams, water tanks, and water towers
- Road and bridge infrastructure, including paved and unpaved roads and bridges
- Airport infrastructure
- Electricity transmission infrastructure
- Natural gas transmission infrastructure
- Communications infrastructure
- Emergency services facilities, excluding hospitals
- Critical political subdivision buildings and infrastructure
- Infrastructure to include water, sewer, roads and parking lots that are required to service recreation and community facilities, excludes the construction of the building or recreational amenity

Ineligible uses of proceeds include:

- Refinancing of existing debt or other obligations
- Routine maintenance and repair projects
- Construction of a recreational building or amenity
- Mixed-use paths and recreational trails
