- ▶ Developed because there had been identified a **lack of awareness, lack of training, and a lack of coordination across existing services.**

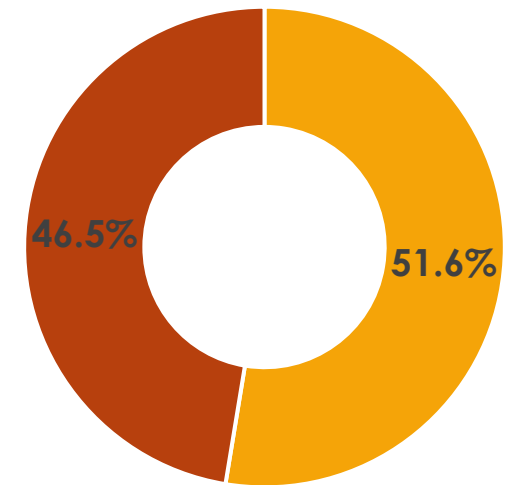
NDBIN meets these needs

 - ▶ **126** Information & Referral clients
 - ▶ **118** Resource Facilitation clients

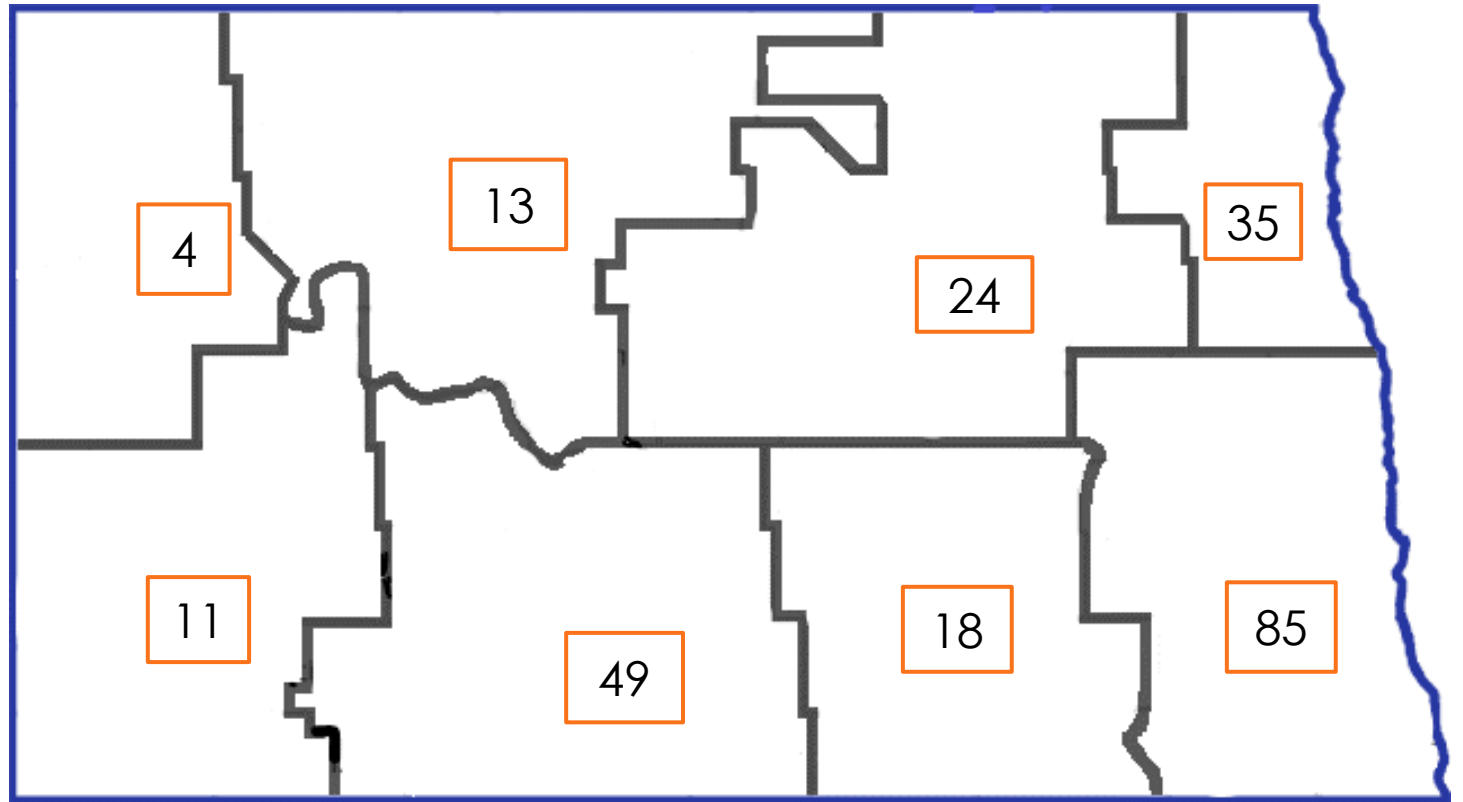
Percent of Clients Served by Program

- Resource Facilitation

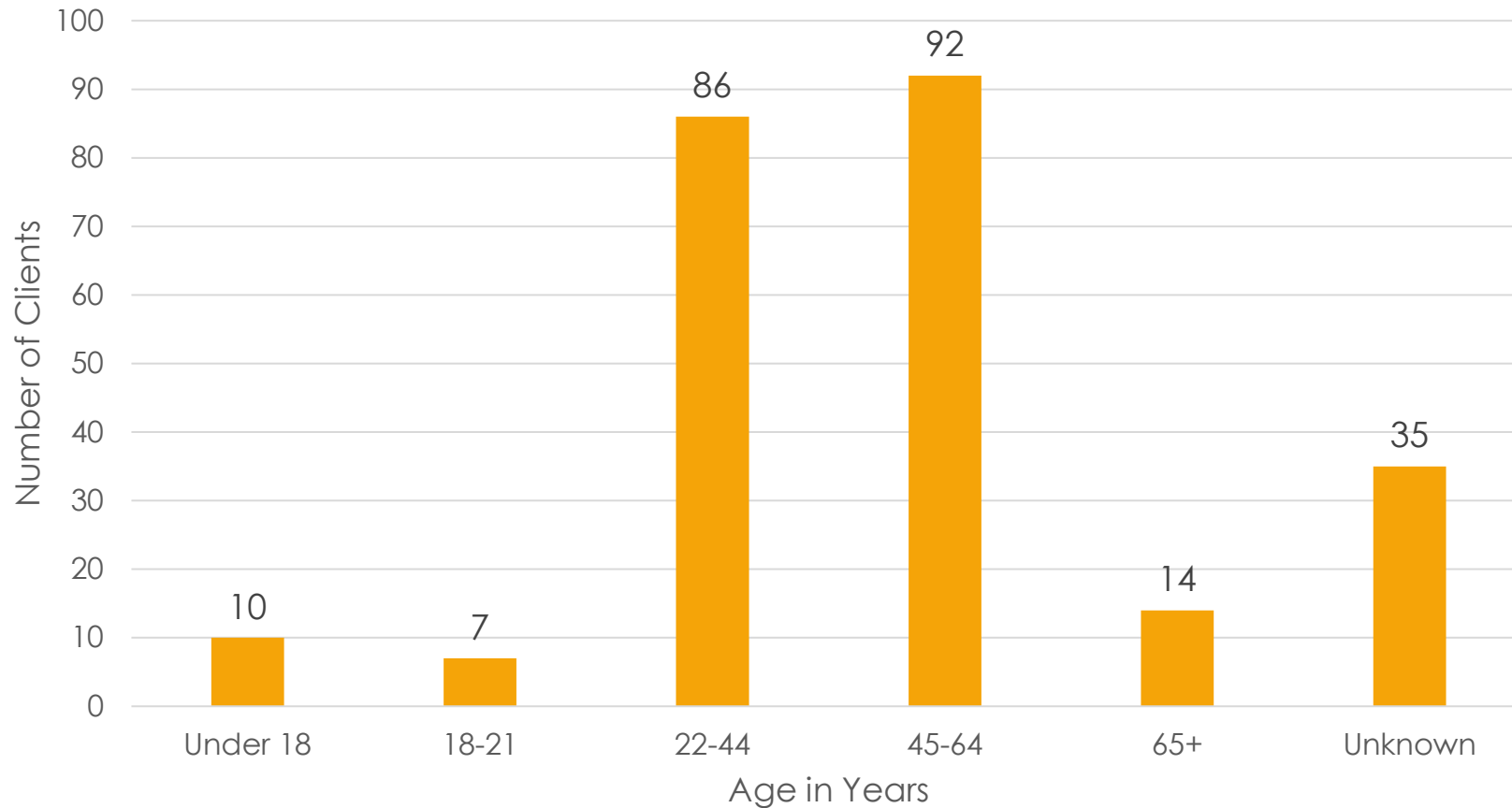
Clients Served by Region

Clients Served by Age

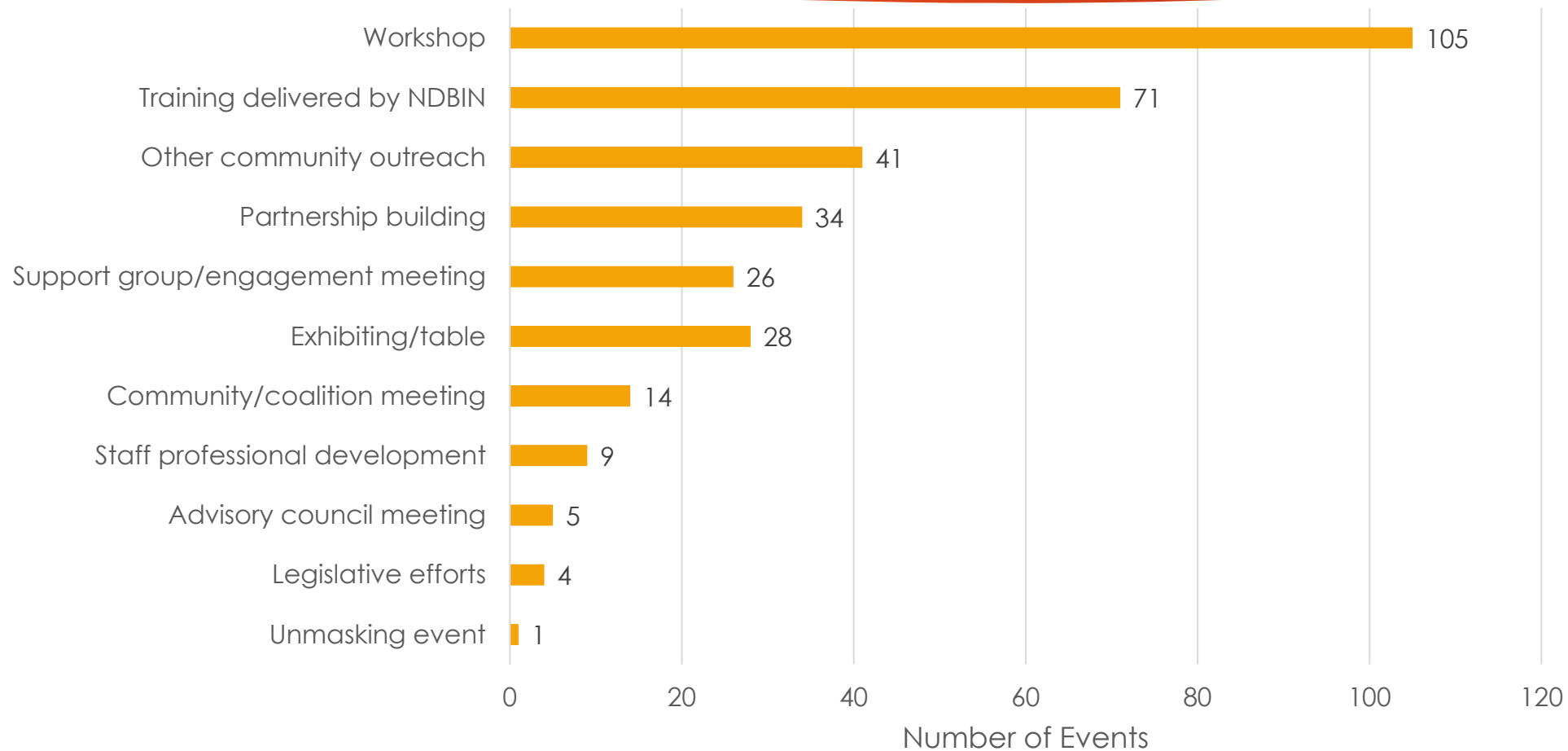


37.7% of clients served were between the ages of 45 and 64 years old

- ▶ **4,100** individuals attended community outreach events

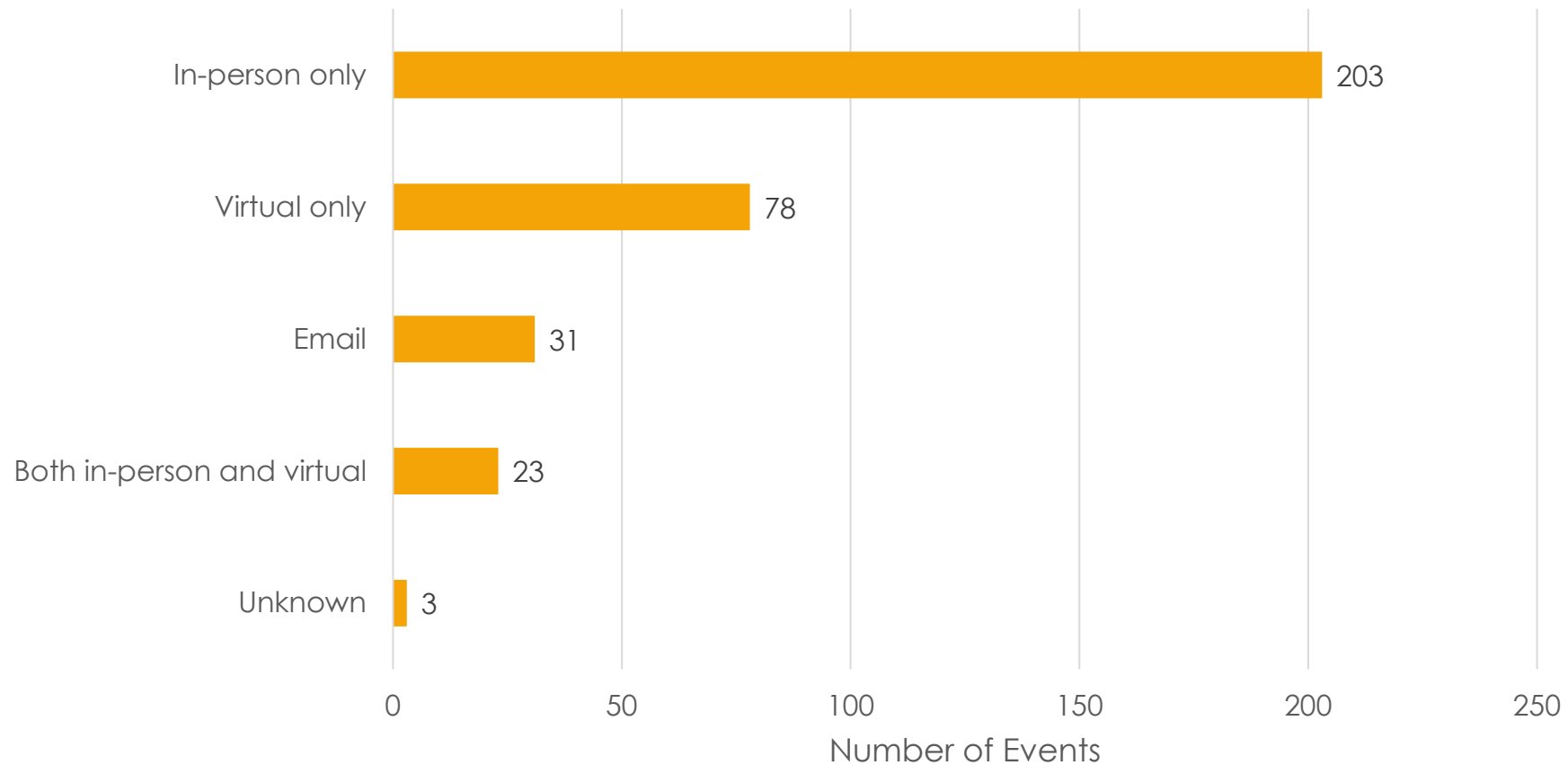
Community Outreach Events by Type



31.0% of outreach events were workshops

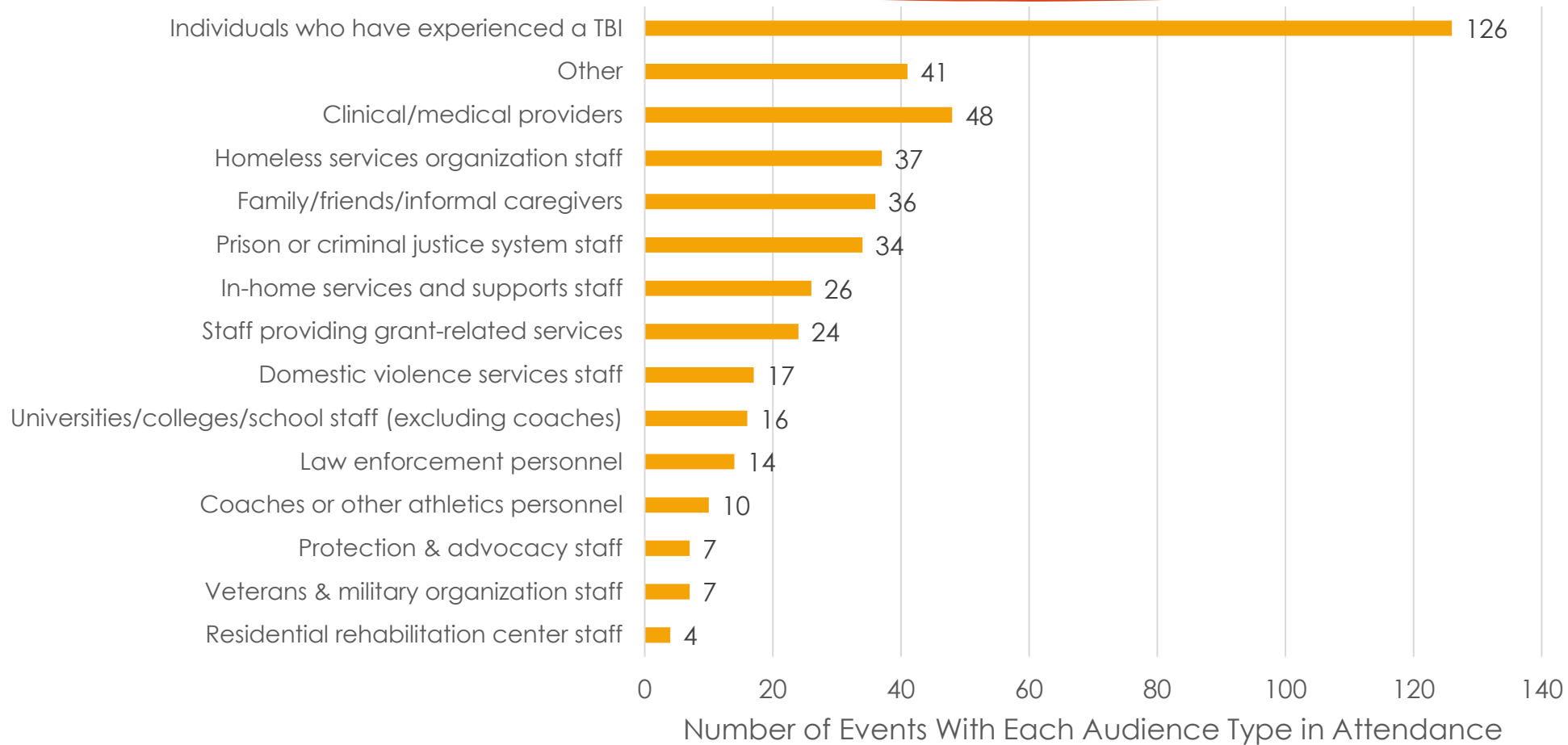
21% of outreach events were trainings delivered by NDBIN

Community Outreach Events by Audience Type

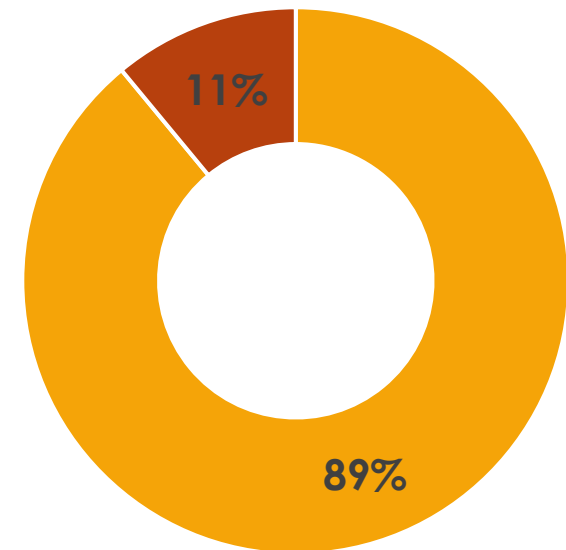


Individuals who have experienced a TBI were the most common audience type at community outreach events

Brain Injury Screening

- ▶ Short OSU TBI-ID/ABI used to screen individuals for brain injury
- ▶ **159** individuals screened from July 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024
 - ▶ **141** screened positive/likely to have a brain injury
 - ▶ **18** screened negative/unlikely to have a brain injury

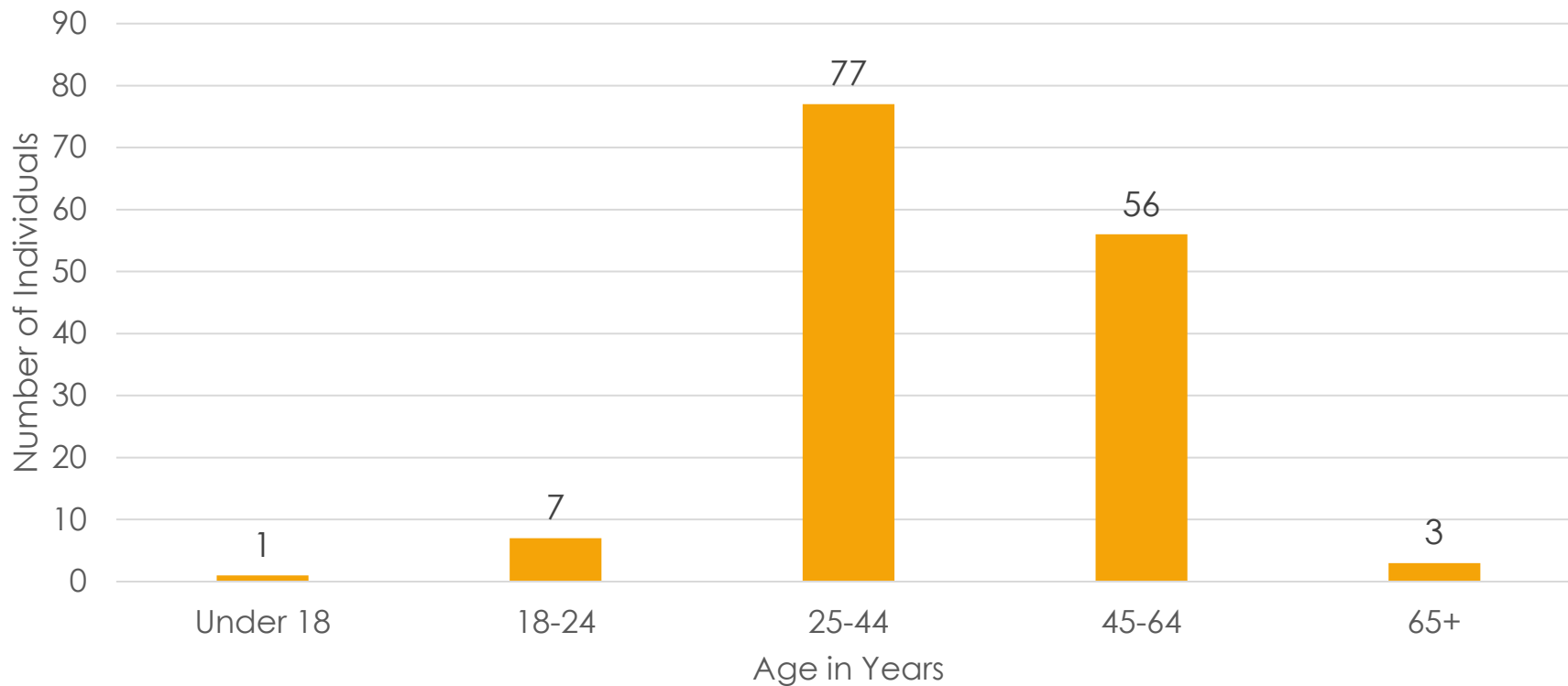
Percent of positive and negative screens
