- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of the North Dakota student teacher scholarship program;
- 3 and to provide an appropriation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## 7 North Dakota student teacher scholarship program.

- 8 <u>1. The state board of higher education shall:</u>
- 9 <u>a.</u> Develop and administer the North Dakota student teacher scholarship program to
   10 <u>provide scholarships for student teachers who will seek initial teacher licensure</u>
   11 after graduation;
  - b. Distribute funds for the scholarships to each institution of higher education in the

    state offering a state-approved teacher preparation program; and

    each approved educator preparation program
    - c. Provide guidance and assistance to an institution of higher education to

      administer the program.
- 16 2. To be eligible to receive a scholarship under this section, a student must:
- 17 <u>a. Be enrolled in a state-approved teacher preparation program and be completing</u>
  18 <u>the student teaching experience in the state;</u>
  - <u>b.</u> Be progressing satisfactorily through the teacher preparation program, as approved educator preparation program determined by the institution of higher education; and
- 21 <u>c. Not hold a teaching license.</u>
- 3. An institution of higher education shall apply a scholarship not exceeding three
   thousand dollars to an eligible student's tuition and fees for the semester the student is
- 24 <u>completing the student teaching experience.</u>

## SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - STUDENT TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$4,200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing funds to institutions of higher education to award scholarships to students who are eligible to receive a student teacher scholarship, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and
