My name is Christopher Hansen, and I live in District 16. I am a parent who has chosen to enroll my children in JPII Catholic Schools because I believe they deserve a high-quality, faith-based education in a safe and structured learning environment.

I am here today to strongly support House Bill No. 1540, but I also support all school choice legislation that allows parents to make the best educational decisions for their children without financial hardship. I support HB 1540 because it expands Education Savings Accounts (ESAs), allowing 80% of perstudent state funding to be used for tuition, textbooks, and tutoring.

Our family has experienced both public and private education, and we made the intentional choice to switch to private school due to the declining safety and accountability issues in public schools. Our son attended and graduated from public school, and during that time, we saw multiple incidents of violence, school lockdowns, and legal issues involving teachers and administrators.
