Student education services account - College save program rollover - Refunds.

- Upon graduation from high school, the parent may transfer account funds to the college save program, if the child is enrolled at an institution of higher education in the state.
- If a child no longer resides in the state, does not pursue higher education, or enrolls in an institution of higher education located in another state, the account is closed and the funds contributed by the parent must be refunded to the parent.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA - STUDENT EDUCATION SERVICES ACCOUNT - PILOT PROGRAM. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$41,200,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the Bank of North Dakota, for the purpose of funding and administrating the student education services account pilot program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The Bank of North Dakota may use up to \$1,200,000, to administer the program.
