Neutral Testimony of Doug Sharbono, citizen of North Dakota on HB1458 in the Sixty-ninth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

Dear Chairman Ruby and members of the House Human Services Committee,

I am writing as a citizen and believe HB1458 could be great and needed legislation with an appropriate amendment. This legislation prohibits the spread or release of a self-spreading virus.

Please give HB1458 a needed amendment exempting citizens who use a minimum standard of care in not spreading viruses. This amendment could make it a great bill and defend us from the disasters we saw unfold in 2020.
