2 commission of a violation of this section be impounded by a peace officer for up to six
3 months.

4 **SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE PAROLE BOARD.**

- 5 1. During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the
6 state parole board. The study must include a comprehensive review of chapter 12-59
7 of the North Dakota Century Code and any rules and regulations adopted by the state
8 parole board relating to:
- 9 a. Members of the board, the appointment process by the governor, terms of board
10 members, parole board meetings, quorum requirements, scheduling, and
11 meeting minutes;
 - 12 b. Inmate eligibility, including an analysis of the board's activities relating to eligibility
13 requirements for parole, conditions, board determinations, victim rights and victim
14 assistance, automated victim information and notification, and the board's action
15 to grant, deny, revoke, or rescind parole; and
 - 16 c. The department of corrections and rehabilitation, including participation in the
17 parole board process and recommendations to the parole board, if any.
- 18 2. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together
19 with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth
20 legislative assembly.

21 **SECTION 13. APPLICATION.** Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, and 10 of this Act apply to
22 individuals who are charged after July 31, 2025, with violations subject to the provisions of this
23 Act.
