- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-05.1-02 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to discretionary special allocation hunting licenses.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-05.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-05.1-02. Discretionary special allocation hunting license authorization.**

- 7 1. Subject to the restrictions under this section and in addition to the special allocation
8 licenses authorized under section 20.1-05.1-01, if determined appropriate by the
9 director based on the sustainability of the species population, the director may issue to
10 eligible organizations the following annual special allocation hunting licenses:
- 11 a. Not more than two elk licenses, but the total issued under this subdivision may
12 not exceed two percent of the general lottery allocation of elk licenses for the
13 season.
 - 14 b. Not more than two moose licenses, but the total issued under this subdivision
15 may not exceed two percent of the general lottery allocation of moose licenses
16 for the season.
 - 17 c. Not more than two antelope licenses, but the total issued under this subdivision
18 may not exceed two percent of the general lottery allocation of antelope licenses
19 for the previous season.
 - 20 d. Not more than ten white-tailed deer licenses.

1 2. An eligible organization may apply annually to be considered for issuance of up to two
2 special allocation hunting licenses under this section. Applications under this
3 subsection must be filed at the times, in the manner, and containing the information
4 required by rules adopted by the director. If more applications are filed than the
5 number of licenses under this section available for that species for a season, the
6 director shall determine by lottery which organizations will receive the available
7 licenses. The director shall award an eligible organization an additional entry in a
8 lottery for available licenses for each twenty percent of the net proceeds of any raffle
9 of a license contributed by the eligible organization to a conservation-related project in
10 addition to the requirements under subsection 5.

11 3. An eligible organization that obtains a license under this section and conducts a raffle
12 or auction to determine the recipient of the license must conduct the raffle or auction in
13 compliance with rules adopted by the director. An eligible organization that obtains a
14 license under this section shall submit reports concerning a raffle or auction as the
15 director requires. An individual may apply to receive an elk or moose license through a
16 raffle or auction under this section as well as through the game and fish department
17 general lottery. If an individual receives an elk or moose license under this section, the
18 individual is not eligible to receive an elk or moose license through the game and fish
19 department general lottery that year and may not obtain an elk or moose license under
20 section 20.1-05.1-01 that year. If an individual receives an elk or moose license under
21 section 20.1-05.1-01, the individual is not eligible to receive an elk or moose license
22 under this section that year.

23 4. An individual who has been convicted of illegally taking a moose, elk, or bighorn sheep
24 is not eligible to apply for or receive a license under this section.

25 5. For purposes of this section, "eligible organization" means an organization that:
26 a. Is exempt from federal income taxation under section 501(c)(~~3~~) of the Internal
27 Revenue Code [26 U.S.C. 501(c)(~~3~~)] and provides with its application a copy of
28 the letter from the internal revenue service to that effect-;
29 b. Is on file as a nonprofit corporation in good standing in the office of the secretary
30 of state-;

- 1 | c. Agrees in its application to contribute at least ~~ten percent~~ twenty percent of the
2 | net proceeds of any raffle of a license under this section to a conservation-related
3 | project to be conducted in this state and approved by the director; and
4 | d. Is not the recipient of a special allocation hunting license under section
5 | 20.1-05.1-01.
