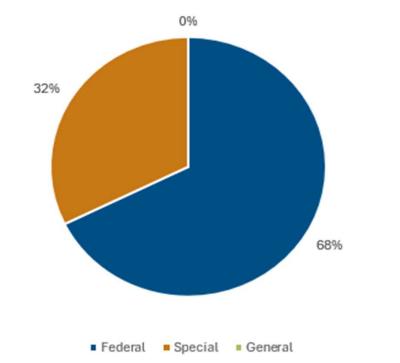
Agency Introduction

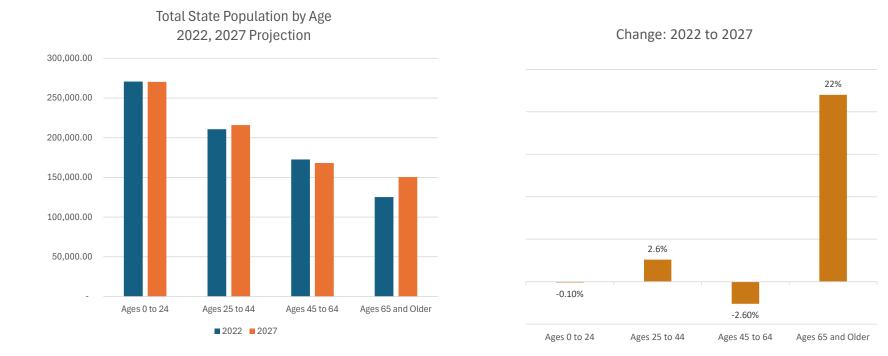

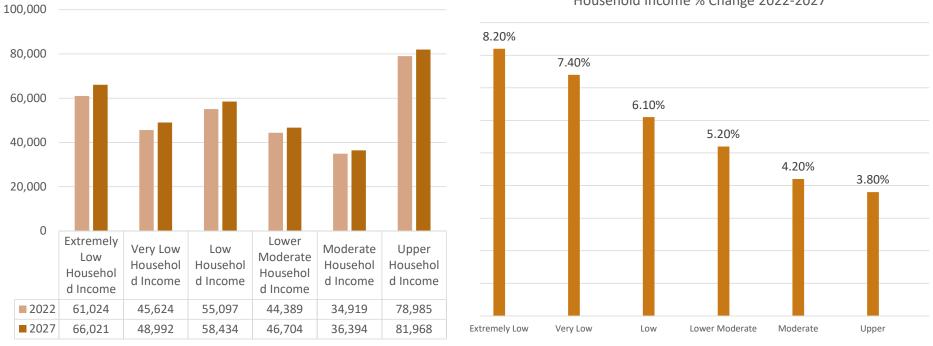
Total state population by age 2022, 2027 projection – and Percent Change from 2022-2027

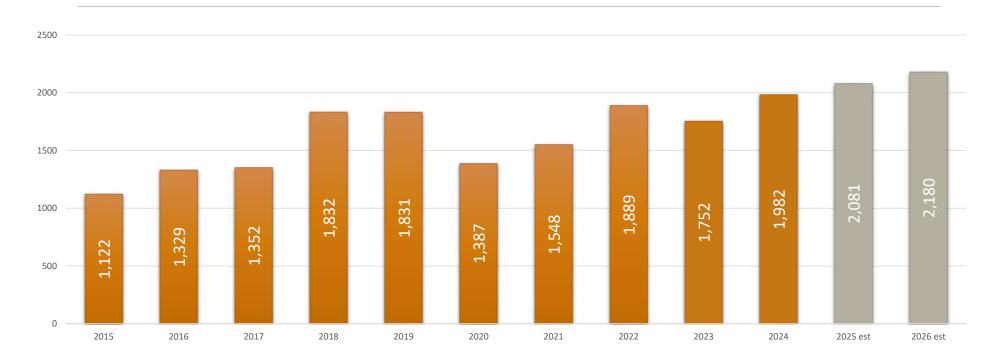

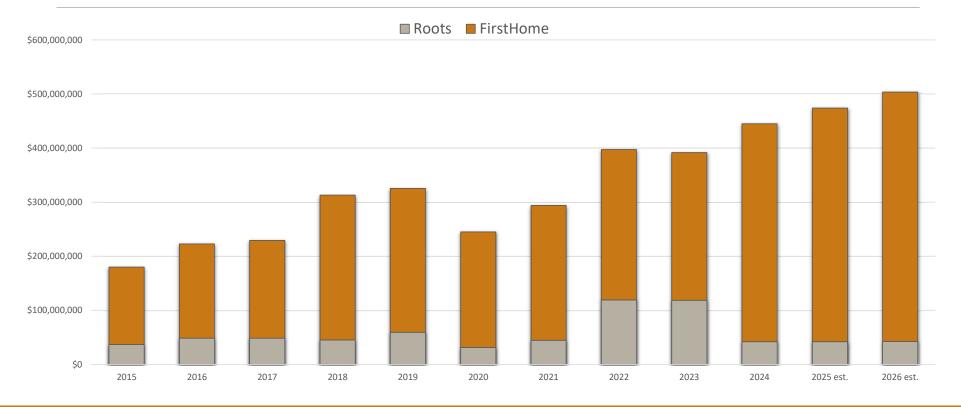

Rate averaged 1.26% below market in 2024

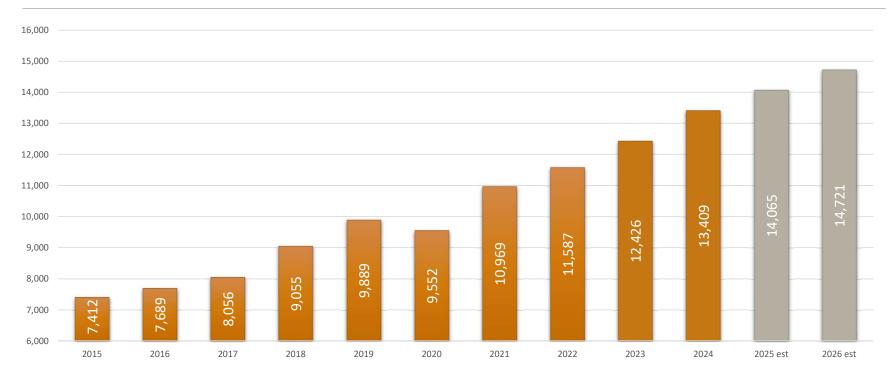
Average monthly payment savings = \$179 Loans serviced in state

Acquisition Staffing

- Adequate staffing needed to ensure:
 - Loans are reviewed and purchased timely from lenders
 - Borrowers receive loan payment information timely

- Current loans serviced = 13,409
- Agency 1,031/FTE
- Mortgage Bankers Association 835/FTE
- Currently we are short 3 FTE's

 - Accountant 1 FTE

FTE History

FTE Pool

- 4.5% vacancy rate anticipated
- Reduced budget by \$465,165
- Actual vacancy rate = 1.85%
- Average vacancy days = 45
- Vacancy savings = \$35,188
- Vacancy savings = 0.34% of base salary line

- Maintain quality service to citizens and our housing partners
- Manage future housing market growth
- Meet investor, bond rating, and federal regulatory guidelines
- Address succession planning for key personnel

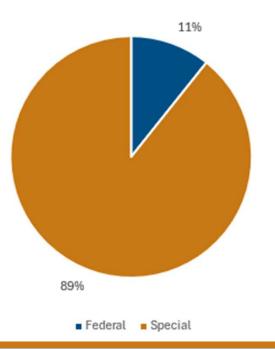
