My name is Shannon Duerr, and I serve as the Executive Director of the Cavalier County Job Development Authority (JDA). I also sit on the advisory council for the Langdon Research Extension Center. - 4. **Ensuring workplace safety for seedsmen** SB 2020 includes provisions to address safety hazards identified during annual inspections at seed stations. No one should have to risk their safety to perform the critical work of seed production.

Agriculture is the backbone of North Dakota's economy and communities, particularly in counties like Cavalier, where it remains a cornerstone of our strategic vision for growth and development. By investing in the safety, quality, and sustainability of our agricultural infrastructure, SB 2020 will strengthen our rural communities and ensure the continued success of this vital industry.
