

- Funded from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services through the state's seven Community Action Agencies.
- Funds are managed and distributed by Division of Community Services (DCS).

# **CSGB Funds**

#### IMPACTED 36,579 LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS

- 13,130 children.
- 6,047 persons with disabilities.
- 4,890 people who lacked health insurance.
- 2,537 individuals who obtained safe & affordable housing.
- 3,873 individuals who improved energy efficiency and/or energy burden reduction in their homes.

### **CARES Funding Results**

DCS RECEIVED ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE ESG AND CSBG PROGRAMS TO ASSIST WITH THE CHALLENGES OF THE PANDEMIC.

- CSBG received an additional \$4,209,178.50, and from these funds:
  - Community Action Agencies have assisted 4,984 low-income clients in 2020 and 2021. In 2022, all 7 CAA's successfully spent down their allocations.
  - An additional \$5,142,580 was received to provide support to the ESG grant.
