Chairperson Dever and Members of the Senate Appropriations-Human Resources Division Committee, my name is Allen Anderson and I am the administrator for Walsh County Health District.

I am in support of HB 1012 which includes \$8,000,000 state aid to local public health units. However, I would like to encourage consideration to increase this amount to \$10,000,000. State aid is one of our only flexible funding sources and fills gaps that other funding can't cover. In 2024 state aid comprised only 6% of our annual revenue. The flexibility of this funding allows us to adapt our programming to our community's needs.

Flexible State Aid funding is crucial in the filling of gaps for the needs of the public. It allows us to keep services running when other funding expires. We have used the funding to fund our adult home visiting program, administration functions, school nursing, and many other programs.

As we work towards reducing chronic disease and improving the health of North Dakotans, I urge you to amend the local state aid funding to help in achieving these goals and pass HB 1012.
