SECTION XX. INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITY GRANT – APPLICATION.

Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$4,400,000 from the general fund for the purpose of providing a one-time grant to a provider in the south central human service region. An entity may receive the grant under this section if the entity is an intermediate care facility, provides early intervention, clinical services, residential services, community and home support, education, recreation and leisure, and assistive technology, provides services in at least eight communities for individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities, and the grant funds will be used only for the costs of providing services to medically and behaviorally complex children and young adults. The requirements of chapter 54-44.4 do not apply to the selection of a grant recipient, the grant award, or payments made under this section.

SECTION XX. SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS GRANT – APPLICATION.

Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$50,000 from the general fund for the purpose of providing a one-time grant to a provider in the south central human service region. An entity may receive the grant under this section if the entity provides state-wide educational, informational, training and workshops, and peer support to families with children with special health care needs, medically complex, or have a disability and the grant funds will be used only for the costs of such services. The requirements of chapter 54-44.4 do not apply to the selection of a grant recipient, the grant award, or payments made under this section.
