- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of commerce for tribal tourism
- 2 grants; and to provide for a legislative management report.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TRIBAL TOURISM 4 **GRANTS - ONE-TIME FUNDING - LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT REPORT.** There is 5 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise 6 7 appropriated, the sum of \$100,000\$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of providing tribal tourism grants, for the biennium 8 beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. A tribal government in the state may apply to 9 10 the department of commerce for a grant of up to \$20,000 to match funds committed by a tribal government\$100,000 to promote and enhance tribal nation tourism opportunities. The 11 department of commerce may spend the funds appropriated in this section only to the extent 12 13 the tribal government has secured one dollar of matching funds from nonstate sources for every ten dollars provided by the department of commerce. A grant application must include a plan for 14 15 using funds to promote and enhance tribal nation tourism opportunities to be overseen by the department of commerce division of tourism. The department of commerce shall report to 16 legislative management regarding the distribution, use, and impact of grants. The appropriation 17 18 provided in this section is considered a one-time funding item.

¹ One-time funding of \$400,000 is added from the general fund for tribal tourism grants to provide a total of \$500,000. The House approved \$100,000. The amendment also increases the maximum grant award a tribal government is eligible for from \$20,000 to \$100,000 and requires a tribal government that receives a grant to provide matching funds of 10 percent (\$10,000).
