My family has chosen to send our children to a private school based on the educational product, parental ability to influence and be involved and because of the faith-based teaching of the school. My husband and I have been committed to sending our children to a Catholic school, and while we have made significant life changes, as well as done significant financial planning to make this happen, I cannot express how much it would mean to us to have some financial support in this endeavor. The school that our children attend goes above and beyond in meeting the educational goals of the State, with our school being above average in test scores compared to local public schools.
