Good morning, Chairman Beard and members of the Senate
Education Committee. For the record, my name is Mike Bitz. I
am fortunate to serve as the superintendent for Mandan Public
Schools. Thank you for all you do to support education in ND. I
am here today to oppose SB2303. I will be brief.

This bill appropriates \$243,000,000 to private schools without 9 private schools having to account for a nickel of how the 10 appropriation is spent. The only fiscal accountability is to give 11 the parent a receipt for the tuition and provide a bond 12 demonstrating that the school can pay its bills. - As a 13 Conservative and a ND taxpayer, I will tell you that this is not 14 only bad government, it is wrong. ND has great private schools, 15 with good people working in them, but giving anyone 16 \$243,000,000 without any fiscal accountability is a bad idea. If 17 you approve this bill, please put guardrails in place to ensure full 18 accountability for these dollars. The taxpayers of ND deserve 19 this. 20

Also I find it confusing that the legislature is also considering a
 parent's rights bill, that in its current form will not apply to private

schools, even if they take public dollars. If private schools accept 1 public dollars, shouldn't we expect them to open their board 2 meetings and welcome parents to attend, and have the ability to 3 address the school board? Should parents really need to forfeit 4 their rights as parents if the private school chooses to admit their 5 child? Accepting public dollars should mean accepting public 6 accountability! The fact that there is a fiscal note on this bill 7 means these are public dollars. 8
