

SB 2158 Testimony in Support by NDCEL

Good Chairman Weber and members of the Senate Finance and Taxation committee. NDCEL
represents all of your school leaders including Superintendents, Principals, Business
officials, Athletic Directors, SPED Directors, REA Directors, Tech Directors, and CTE
Directors. I am here to support Senate Bill 2158, which provides an essential and flexible
framework for the distribution of unobligated cash balances when a school district dissolves.

For small communities in North Dakota, the dissolution of a school district can be a
challenging and emotional process. I've personally been through this process as a small
school superintendent in South Dakota, and what this bill offers is quite similar to a process
in place with our neighbors to the south. This bill offers two key improvements that are
particularly beneficial:

- Flexibility in Fund Allocation: By allowing county committees to distribute up to
 \$500,000 to another political subdivision, the bill enables the strategic use of funds
 to support vital services or infrastructure. This provision benefits small communities
 by reinforcing public resources like emergency services, libraries, or road
 improvements that contribute to community stability.
- Equity for Property Owners: The option to provide direct cash refunds ensures transparency and tangible financial relief for residents who may experience significant changes in their property taxes during a district transition. This flexibility acknowledges the financial impact on families and ensures that the dissolution process is not a punitive one.
- NDCEL views this bill as a balanced approach to managing public funds that empowers communities, preserves fairness for property owners, and strengthens local services during district dissolutions. The emergency clause appropriately underscores the urgent need for this reform for upcoming transitions in one of our North Dakota communities at this time.
