They already do an amazing job of shepherding our young readers to age-appropriate materials. This bill is entirely unnecessary. It addresses a problem that does not exist.

This bill is government overreach and censorship, and overrides our First Amendment rights. It would impact rural communities like ours, which is fortunate to have our very own small, one-room library. Laws like this threaten its existence, as there's no way our tiny town could fund physically separate sections in that small building.
