

# Statewide Database Program for North Dakota

## July 2024 - June 2025

Thank you for your library's continued participation in the Statewide Database Program. The program serves the full spectrum of library users - from students in K-12 schools, to learners in academic institutions, to lifelong learners in public and special libraries with multidisciplinary database products that include full-text from journals, magazines, other periodicals, news sources, books, web content, and/or video, images, media, and content in other formats.

Resources are negotiated by Minitex (MN) with the collection selected by a task force comprised of funding partners from North Dakota, South Dakota, and Minnesota. ODIN – in collaboration with the North Dakota State Library – provides access\* to participating North Dakota libraries. ## **Billing Explanation**

For FY25, The ND Statewide Database invoice totaled \$280,271. ODIN applied \$111,975 in state appropriated dollars towards the bill. The State Library contributes an additional \$9,600 to further reduce the amount billed to libraries. The remaining amount, **\$158,696**, is billed to participating libraries using the following formula:

- 1. Vendor usage statistics (total platform searches) were gathered based on library type and can be found at https://www.odin.nodak.edu/eresources/statistics.
- 2. Usage percentages by library type are then applied to each vendor's bill.
  - a. Example: Gale/Cengage's bill is \$50,000 after appropriated and earmarked reductions. Gale/Cengage usage percentages were 10% Academic, 85% Schools, and 5% Public Libraries. In this example, Academics would be billed \$5,000, Schools \$42,500, and Public Libraries \$2,500.
- 3. Totals for each vendor are then added together, by library type, and divided by FTE, enrollment, or population depending on type. Here is the calculated rate for FY25:
  - a. Academic Libraries = \$1.95 per FTE (Student and Staff combined)
  - b. Public Libraries = \$0.0134 per service population
  - c. School Libraries = \$1.58 per student enrolled in grades 9-12 last fall
  - d. Special Libraries = **\$100 per library**
