As a parent, I can have parental controls on my kid devices, the Netflix app they watch, even my TV remote provides parental controls for different shows I don't want them to watch, but when it comes to my child's school library, anything goes. Some of the books that are in the school library are loaded with obscene material. Some examples of these obscene material are books with topics like, "eating pussy" in the book Me and Earl and the Dying Girl, "putting his penis in my mouth" in the book Looking for Alaska, "the sticky stuff icing her hands" in the book Identical.
