Chairperson and Members of the Committee,

As someone with deep ND roots and friends and family members in the LGBTQ+ community, I offer testimony in OPPOSITION of House Concurrent Resolution 3013.

As elected officials, you took an oath to uphold the United States Constitution as well as the ND State Constitution. The 14th Amendment of the US Constitution allows for any consenting adults to marry one another. How does HCR 3013 financially, or in any way, benefit ND?
