SUNDAY LIQUOR SALES PROHIBITED

AN ACT

To amend and reenact section 5-0113 of the 1953 Supplement to the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943, relating to the prohibition against selling alcoholic beverages on certain days.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. **Amendment.**) Section 5-0113 of the 1953 Supplement to the North Dakota Revised Code of 1943 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

5-0113. Selling Liquors On Election Day And Memorial Day And Certain Other Days Prohibited; Punishment.) Every person who sells, gives away, or disposes of any alcoholic beverage on Memorial Day, Good Friday, Sunday, after six p.m. on Christmas Eve, on Christmas Day, or on the day of any general, special, or local election, in the village, city or county where held, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than thirty days and by a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or both such fine and imprisonment.

TOWNSHIP BEER OR LIQUOR LICENSES

AN ACT

Prohibiting the issuance of retail beer or liquor licenses by county commissioners without written consent of township supervisors.

Be It Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1.) No retail beer or liquor license shall be issued in any organized township in this state by the board of county commissioners without the written consent of the township supervisors of such township. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the renewal of licenses heretofore issued.
