Agenda: Presentation of information and committee discussion regarding issues related to the severance of hunting access from the surface estate; the feasibility and desirability of establishing legislation for the enforcement and assessment of civil penalties for violation of the one-call excavation notice system; how the state might pursue additional uses of Lake Sakakawea and Missouri River waters for such beneficial purposes as domestic and industrial uses, recreation, fish and wildlife, and irrigation and how the state, to enhance its use of the lake and river, might promote congressional review of the 1944 Flood Control Act and reexamination by the Corps of Engineers of the way in which it manages the Missouri River system; receive a report on the Red River Valley Water Supply Project; and a preliminary report on the State Water Commission's assessment of the impact of tile drainage on the beneficial use of water by prior water appropriators
